Food Bank update

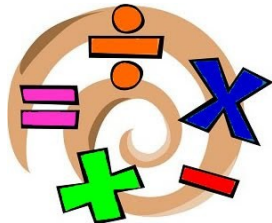
Thank you to Year 5 and 6 for their food bank donations. We will be sending our donations to the **Trussell Trust** in Westminster - www.trusselltrust.org.
