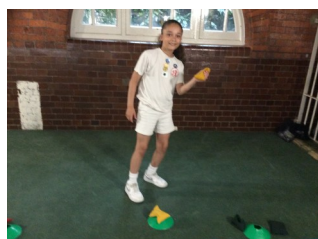


Dear Parents and Carers,

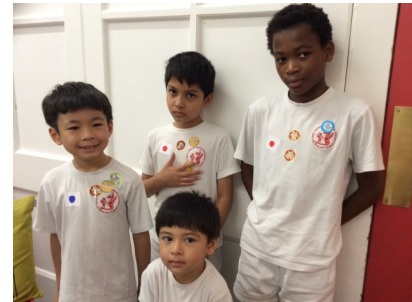

After school enrichment clubs for September

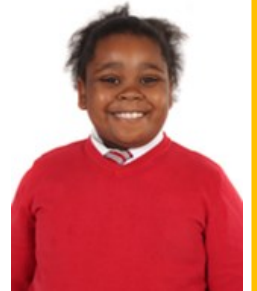
