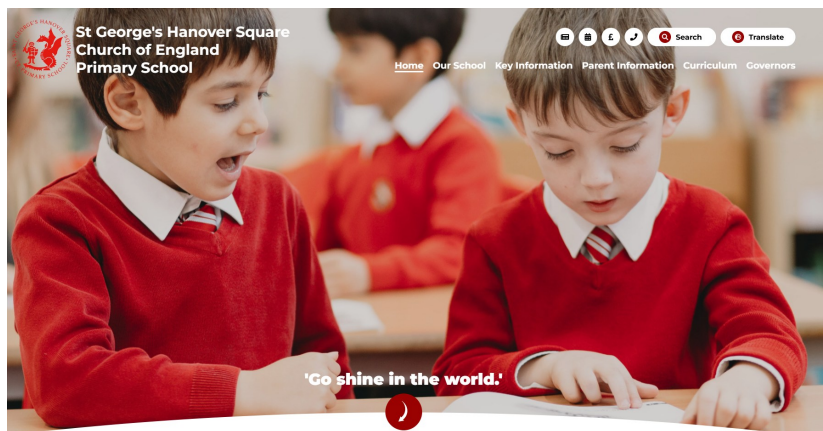


Dear Parents and Carers,

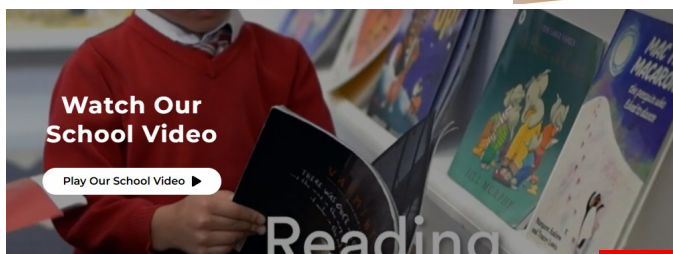
## Our school website

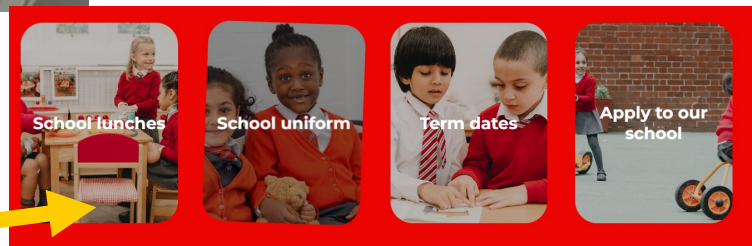

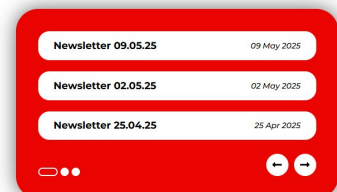
