This week Year 3 and 4 visited Handel & Hendrix House, learning all about its history and composing pieces of music.

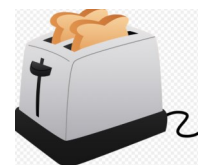


Breakfast Club

Children will then go straight to their classes at **8.40am**.

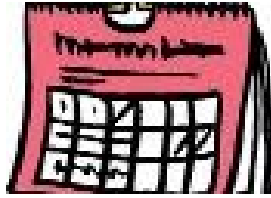
