

## St. George's C of E Primary School Pupil Questionnaire July 2025

We were pleased to see how positive your responses to the questionnaire was and that so many of you are proud to be at St George's. It was a delight to read your comments and suggestions. Thank you for sharing these.

All of you said that you love being at St George's and that you have fun. So many of you said that your teachers are friendly and that you like talking to them because they **listen to you**. Many of you commented that when you are worried or scared, teachers help you feel better. All children could name at **least two adults** they would talk to if they had a worry about something. We are pleased to see that all of you said that you enjoyed coming to school and enjoy your learning at school. We were pleased to see that all **children are proud** to be at St George's.

So many children told us that prayer time is the part of collective worship they enjoy most. You said that you also enjoy mediation every day, as you like the time to be by yourself, with your own thoughts to talk to God. Many of you mentioned **chapel and celebration assembly** as being a highlight of the week.

Many children said learning is what you enjoy most which is great because that's what school is for! Many children told us their favourite subjects and we were glad to hear that **Maths and English** were popular choices, as was **Art and PE**. We were pleased that all of you said that your teachers help you to try your best.

Of course, many children said that playing with their friends at playtime was what you enjoy most. Many children said that other children in the school are **kind and respectful**. This shows our value of **'friendship'**. We were glad to hear that children said that there are lots of options at playtime – new playground games, a new basketball hoop for team games, and benches to chat. We try to provide a good range of options but will buy some more new things for the playground for September.

Lots of you said you enjoy celebrating achievements in celebration assembly; that you like hearing who is **'Person of the Week'**, who has special mentions for showing our **Christian values** and who is a learning hero. It's so important to celebrate our own and others' achievements by showing our value of **'community'**.

Trips were a popular choice for what you enjoy and we are glad that all classes in the school have at least one trip and/or visitor a term. Lots of children mentioned community events – **Movie Night, the family BBQ and the Football Tournament**. **Healthy Heart Day and Word Aware Day** were also popular. You also said that you enjoy the after-school enrichment clubs on offer. Year 6 children mentioned **Sayers Croft** and the excitement of going away on a residential trip.

With the ideas for what we can do to make the school even better, it's always lovely to hear that lots of you say the school is just right and doesn't need anything to get better. Our value of **'excellence'** tells us that we can always get better though. Well done!
