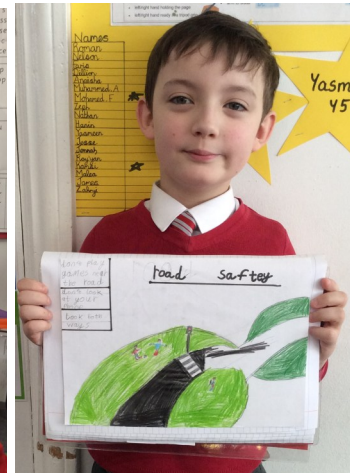
Keeping Safe Studies
