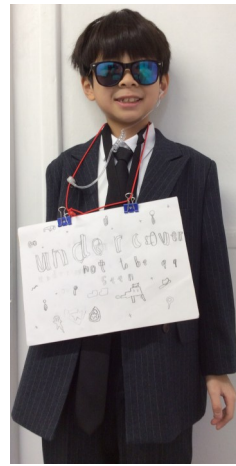
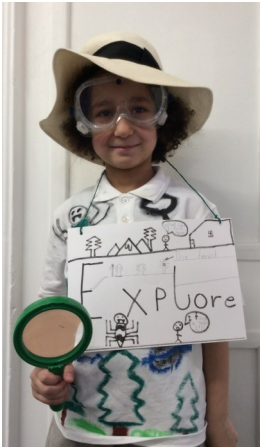
Don't let a little worry turn into a big one...
