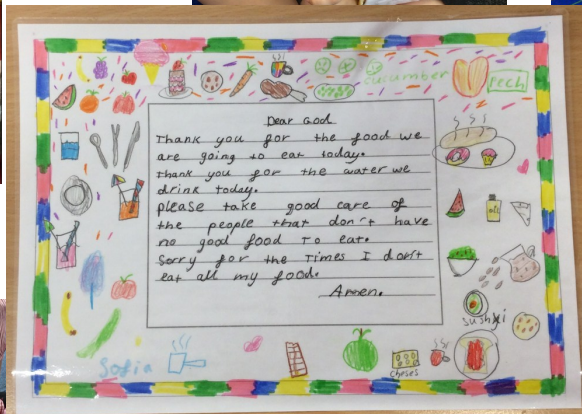

Tickets will be available from the school office from Monday 8th June 2026.

£5.00 ADULT TICKET includes admittance, entertainment, one portion of BBQ food (meat or vegetarian), a portion of salad and a glass of wine or a soft drink.

£3.00 CHILD TICKET includes admittance, entertainment, one portion of BBQ food (meat or vegetarian), a portion of salad and a soft drink.

Tickets numbers are limited for health and safety reasons. Children must be accompanied by an adult who is over 18. Children will not be able to come by themselves.

No refunds can be given if the BBQ is cancelled due to heavy rain or extreme heat. This is because the food, drink and activities have already been paid for.
