School Uniform for Children in Nursery...

Children in Nursery will continue to wear a plain white short-sleeved polo shirt and charcoal grey jogging bottoms with plain black shoes or trainers suitable to learning and playing.

School Uniform for Children in Reception to Year 6...

Children in Year 1 to Year 6 will continue to wear the following 3 items of our school uniform to school:

1. Red jumper or cardigan
2. Red and grey school tie
3. Red bookbag with the school logo

Children in Reception to Year 6 will continue to wear a plain white school shirt, a grey skirt/pinafore/trousers and a red and white gingham summer dress/grey shorts. We are always really pleased to meet with you and chat things through.



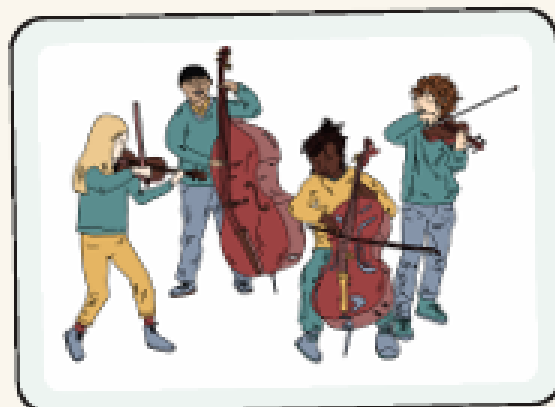
